AKC Health EARLY DETECTION TCC/UC TEST

AKC is working with North Carolina State University's College of Veterinary Medicine and Sentinel Biomedical to offer dog lovers and breeders a new, ground-breaking product that offers early canine bladder cancer detection as well as an opportunity to participate in a national research study.

Introducing the CADET BRAF Mutation Detection Assay

This year, bladder cancer (also known as transitional cell carcinoma (TCC), or urothelial carcinoma (UC) will be diagnosed in an estimated 80,000 dogs. Generally, most cases off TCC/UC are not diagnosed until late in the course of the disease, generally after multiple rounds of ineffective antibiotic treatment, incurring extra expense, wasting precious time, and allowing the cancer to spread.

The CADET BRAF Mutation Detection Assay is a simple free-catch urine analysis test that detect the present of TCC/UC months before any clinical signs of the disease are present, allowing for the earliest therapeutic intervention.



DOG FOOD RECALL

BLUE RIDGE BEEF PET FOOD RECALLS

December 2016

December 8, 2016 — Blue Ridge Beef of Eatonton, Georgia has voluntarily recalled two of its frozen products due to their potential be contaminated to with Salmonella and/or Listeria monocytogenes.

The affected products are sold in 2 pound chubs and can be identified with the following manufacturing codes: Lot #mfd ga8516, BEEF FOR DOGS, UPC code 8542980011009; and Lot #mfd ga81216, GRIND, UPC KITTEN 854298001016.

The affected products were distributed to retail stores in the following states: Arizona, Florida, Georgia, North Carolina, South Carolina and Texas.

This recall was initiated after the FDA received two complaints associated with these products, including one complaint of two kitten illnesses and one complaint of a puppy death. Subsequent testing by the FDA of a 2 pound chub of beef for dogs and kitten grind collected at a veterinary office revealed the presence of Salmonella and Listeria monocytogenes. This recall is being made with the knowledge of the U.S. Food and Drug Administration.

January 17, 2017 — Blue Ridge Beef of Eatonton, Georgia, has voluntarily recalled one lot of its Turkey with Bone raw frozen product due to its potential to Ъе contaminated with Listeria monocytogenes.

The affected product is sold in 2 pound chubs and can be identified with the following manufacturing codes: BLUE RIDGE BEEF TURKEY WITH BONE, Size: 2 pound chubs, UPC Code 854298001887, Lot #103 mfdga12716.

The affected products were distributed to retail stores in the following states: Florida, Georgia, North Carolina, and South Carolina.



Talk code to your veterinarian about how much food your dog needs on a daily basis.

Look for dog foods with omega-3 fatty acids, like EPA (eicosapentaenoic acid) and DHA (docosahexaenoic acid). Also, it should have a minimum of 25% protein from a good-quality protein source. Ask your veterinarian for help finding the right diet. Date Keep an eye on the scale: Or, rather, the 2/2 body condition chart. Monitoring a senior 2/3 dog's weight and body condition helps to 2/4 identify obesity sooner, so it can be 2/5 managed more effectively. A dog should $\frac{2}{2/5}$ have an hourglass shape when viewed 2/6 from above, which equates to a score of 4 2/18 or 5 on a nine-point body condition score 2/19 2/24 system (which is good). 2/25




