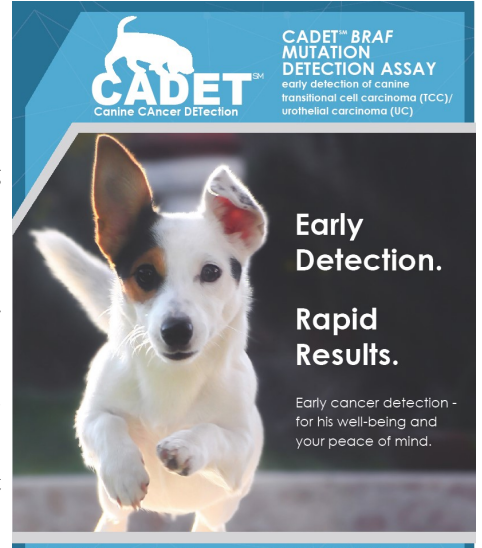
EARLY DETECTION TCC/UC TEST

AKC is working with North Carolina State University's College of Veterinary Medicine and Sentinel Biomedical to offer dog lovers and breeders a new, ground-breaking product that offers early canine bladder cancer detection as well as an opportunity to participate in a national research study.

Introducing the CADET BRAF Mutation Detection Assay

This year, bladder cancer (also known as transitional cell carcinoma (TCC), or urothelial carcinoma (UC) will be diagnosed in an estimated 80,000 dogs. Generally, most cases of TCC/UC are not diagnosed until late in the course of the disease, generally after multiple rounds of ineffective antibiotic treatment, incurring extra expense, wasting precious time, and allowing the cancer to spread.

The CADET BRAF Mutation Detection Assay is a simple free-catch urine analysis test that detects the presence of TCC/UC months before any clinical signs of the disease are present, allowing for the earliest therapeutic intervention.

As an exclusive offer to AKC registrants, the test is available for a reduced fee via the online THE AKC Shop with two ordering options: 1) an Annual Screening subscription to screen one dog three times a year, and 2) as a Breeder Screening Pack to conduct an initial screening of multiple dogs at once. Both options include the supplies needed for collecting urine samples at home and free shipping to the testing laboratory, with results delivered within two weeks of sample receipt.

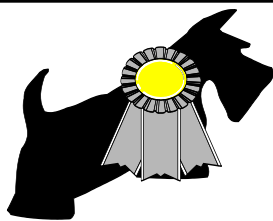

DOG FOOD RECALL

**BLUE RIDGE BEEF
PET FOOD RECALLS**

December 2016

December 8, 2016 — Blue Ridge Beef of Eatonton, Georgia has voluntarily recalled two of its frozen products due to their potential to be contaminated with Salmonella and/or Listeria monocytogenes.

The affected products are sold in 2 pound chubs and can be identified with the following manufacturing codes: Lot #mfd ga8516, BEEF FOR DOGS, UPC code 8542980011009; and Lot #mfd ga81216, KITTEN GRIND, UPC code 854298001016.

The affected products were distributed to retail stores in the following states: Arizona, Florida, Georgia, North Carolina, South Carolina and Texas.

This recall was initiated after the FDA received two complaints associated with these products, including one complaint of two kitten illnesses and one complaint of a puppy death. Subsequent testing by the FDA of a 2 pound chub of beef for dogs and kitten grind collected at a veterinary office revealed the presence of Salmonella and Listeria monocytogenes. This recall is being made with the knowledge of the U.S. Food and Drug Administration.

January 17, 2017 — Blue Ridge Beef of Eatonton, Georgia, has voluntarily recalled one lot of its Turkey with Bone raw frozen product due to its potential to be contaminated with Listeria monocytogenes.

The affected product is sold in 2 pound chubs and can be identified with the following manufacturing codes: BLUE RIDGE BEEF TURKEY WITH BONE, Size: 2 pound chubs, UPC Code 854298001887, Lot #103 mfdga12716.

The affected products were distributed to retail stores in the following states: Florida, Georgia, North Carolina, and South Carolina.

This recall was initiated as a result of an FDA inspection and sampling of the product, and is being made with the knowledge of the US Food and Drug Administration.

3 Tips on Feeding Your Senior Dog

Aging starts with providing proper nutrition throughout a dog's life, but it is never too late to begin feeding a healthy diet to help increase your old dog's time with you. Here are some tips on feeding senior dogs from the AKC Canine Health Foundation.

Get out the measuring cups: One of the keys to longevity is preventing obesity. Overweight dogs, the CHC reports, are more prone to diseases like osteoarthritis, diabetes mellitus, respiratory and cardiovascular disorders, and cancer. Talk to your veterinarian about how much food your dog needs on a daily basis.

Buy the good stuff: Senior dogs should be fed complete and balanced nutrition that contains an optimal blend of vitamins, minerals, and other nutrients to help support their joints and other tissues. Look for dog foods with omega-3 fatty acids, like EPA (eicosapentaenoic acid) and DHA (docosahexaenoic acid). Also, it should have a minimum of 25% protein from a good-quality protein source. Ask your veterinarian for help finding the right diet.

Keep an eye on the scale: Or, rather, the body condition chart. Monitoring a senior dog's weight and body condition helps to identify obesity sooner, so it can be managed more effectively. A dog should have an hourglass shape when viewed from above, which equates to a score of 4 or 5 on a nine-point body condition score system (which is good).

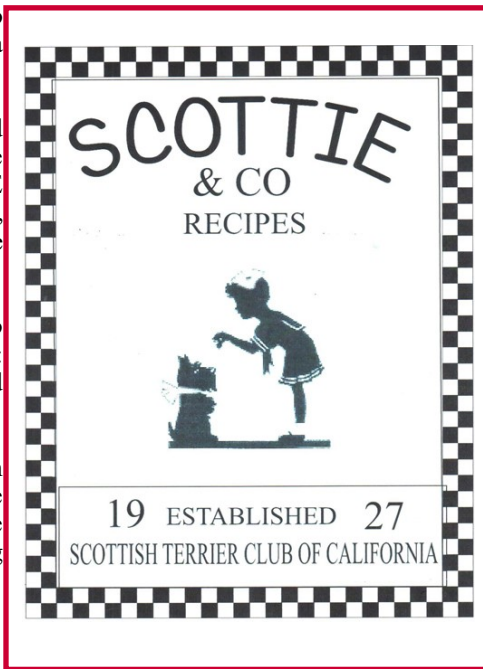
As a value-added part of the testing process, dog owners and breeders have an opportunity to join a nationwide study to help researchers better understand the environmental factors associated with cancer in dogs and in humans, making our dogs the true watchdogs in the area of human health.

The AKC package of information can be found on the STCC web site; www.stccalifornia.org. The package includes a 16 page product guide pamphlet in pdf, and 6 FAQ videos (mp4 format) titled: TRAINING VIDEO, PRODUCT VIDEO, WHAT ARE KIT CONTENTS, WHAT HAPPENS IF NOT ENOUGH SAMPLE, WHY IS IT RECOMMENDED TO TAKE TEST 3x A YEAR, and WHY START TESTING AT AGE 5.

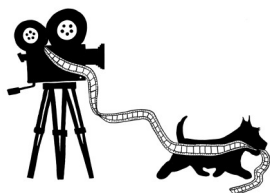
STCC/GWTA 2017 SPECIALTIES UPDATES

We've stayed busy throughout the holiday period and just a month into the new year we continue to be quite busy.

In our last Rescue Report we told you about our newest rescued Scottie, Reno, a three-year-old wheaten male, who had come to us from a dog hoarding situation and needed rescuing.

I think we all occasionally read about or see TV news programs that report about dog and/or cat hoarding situations, usually right on the day that they get busted by their local animal control agencies, but we've never had a Scottie from one ... until Reno.

He is a very, very, large Scottie weighing 47 pounds and not overweight as you can see in his photo.



Reno, and over 100 dogs were held for six weeks as "evidence" dogs. Once the hoarder agreed to "sign off" as their owner, they became available for adoption. The hoarder was living in the Topanga Canyon area when neighbors reported her and she was arrested and the dogs were confiscated.

I thought that Reno's only negative was that he is a "major puller" on our daily neighborhood walks, as I mentioned last month, but it has turned out that he has a gift for escaping a yard, too.

I'd signed him into a training facility for two weeks in early December and they were able to get him to "pull" much less, by using an "Easy Walk" harness combined with other training techniques.

While he was there a home became available so I picked him up from the training facility about a week sooner than had been planned. His new adopter lives a great distance from me in San Luis Obispo and we had made arrangements to meet part way just one week before Christmas.

All went well with with the three animals and she really liked Reno, sending photos to me almost every day.

Then came a heart-stopping email that I was reading late one night. She'd gone out grocery shopping, the first time she'd left home since she'd adopted Reno six days before, and when she got home an hour later, Reno was gone. I think my heart stopped beating for a few seconds until I read her next paragraph, saying she'd jumped in her car and found him a few blocks from her home sniffing some bushes. She opened the car door and he jumped in.

I called her first thing the next morning after a very sleepless night and said, "Judy, I've got to get Reno back today because he will escape again, the very next time you leave."

SCOTTIE RESCUE

So now Reno is here in Rescue again, awaiting a home that wants a very sweet-natured, big wheaten Scottie and also has a block wall fence. He would no doubt dig out again, if the fence were wood or chainlink, unless it was built on concrete.

"Doc" Holliday, a black nine-year-old Scottie came to us in mid-November. His family had recently moved from a house in Florida with a big yard, to a condo in Riverside with no yard. Soon after the move the husband was diagnosed with cancer and was no longer able to take him for even a short walk ... and the wife was scheduled for hip replacement surgery in December. This couple were both in tears when I picked Doc up.

Very few of our adopters want a Scottie over six years old, but Doc was very lucky! One of our previous adopters, a senior herself, had lost her Scottie to bladder cancer a few months before and was calling me every few weeks wanting to adopt another one. I called to tell her about Doc and she was so excited and happy and said, "When can you bring him, Carol? I can be here anytime."

I could tell that she wasn't exactly thrilled with the name "Doc," but when I told her that Doc's first owner named him in honor of her father (everyone had called her dad "Doc" Holliday, even though this wasn't his actual name) she smiled and said "that's a nice story."

Doc now has a beautiful tree-shaded yard in a very upscale gated community adjacent to Century City. Besides his new mom, he has two maids to take him for walks two or three times a day. Each time I've been there I've seen many, many dogs being walked.

Our two four-month-old puppies... now about seven-months-old ... are doing very well in their San Francisco Bay area homes. I told you about Siggy's new home in the November Bulletin but not Mattie's.

Both puppies have moms who work from home so they have company and supervision all the time. Mattie's mom is a writer.

They had a first playdate with each other at Siggy's home. Here are some email excerpts written to me: "Mattie's doing great: Yesterday she met a whole class of

school kids and some of the girls walked her inside a closed park. Training classes start in a couple of weeks. She needs to meet more dogs in a controlled setting ... "

And from Siggy's mom: "Happy new year from all five of us! All is well with our pack. Siggy completed puppy 101 and we're having a trainer over to go over his barking



and alpha behavior. He's a great little guy with a huge personality! Reggie keeps trying to put him in his place. And Frannie is still nervous of him--haha ... "

For the record, I rarely adopt Scotties out of Southern California, however, both of these families had originally adopted their first Scotties from me while living in the San Fernando Valley and I'd been to their homes and knew they were good Scottie owners. They'd also contacted the SF Bay area Scottie Rescue, at my suggestion, but hadn't heard back from them.
